Lessons for September 18

FIRST LESSON: (Amos 8:4-7) A judgment on social injustice and religious hypocrisy.

PSALM: (Psalm 113) Praise to the Lord enthroned on high who lifts up the weak and lowly.

SECOND LESSON: (1 Timothy 2:1-7) Disciples are called upon to pray for all, including political rulers, so that Christians may lead peaceable and moral lives. It is God's will that everyone should find salvation.

GOSPEL: (Luke 16:1-13) The story of the steward who, when dismissed for mismanagement, showed himself to be very shrewd. This is followed by teaching about Mammon, that is, worldly wealth.
