**Lessons for May 28**

**FIRST LESSON:** (Acts 1:6-14) We hear of Jesus' promise of empowerment for mission by the Holy Spirit, after which he is envisioned being lifted up into heaven.

**PSALM:** (Psalm 68:1-10, 33-36) A psalm of praise to the mighty God who has brought his people out of Egypt and saved Israel from her enemies. He resigns on high.

**SECOND LESSON:** (1 Peter 4:12-14, 5:6-11) When Christians find it necessary to suffer for their faith, they are to know that they are sharing in Christ's sufferings.

**GOSPEL:** (John 17:1-11) Jesus asks the Father that his glory may be made fully known in his Son, and he prays for disciples through whom the glory now shines.
