Thoughts from your Treasurer

I just finished reading the book “Debt-Proof Living” by Mary Hunt. One of her five required suggestions is to live on 80% of your take home pay, save 10%, and share 10%. The author is not a financial guru, and does not even use ROI (return on investment) or IRR (Internal Rate of Return for the time value of money) in her book. Instead, like a mother or school teacher, she gives concrete plans and actions that real people have a chance of accomplishing. While the rest of the book contains extremely good advice, I thought her rational for sharing or giving away 10% was most interesting. She states that you cannot appreciate what you have unless you share it with someone. It changes the mind-set from scarcity to abundance, from not having enough to having more than necessary. Spending money on ourselves can create a temporary feeling of happiness in some people, but giving and sharing with others creates a long term joyous attitude in our lives. Our human minds cannot perform hoarding for ourselves and sharing with others at the same time. I have found the sharing part to work better in my life.

Lessons for June 25

FIRST LESSON: (Jeremiah 20:7-13) Jeremiah complains to the Lord. He is torn between wanting to give up his mission and his need to speak in God's name and to put his trust in him.

PSALM: (Psalm 69:8-18) An individual who is sunk in distress and reproach calls upon the Lord for rescue.

SECOND LESSON: (Romans 6:1b-11) As Christian disciples have been joined with Christ in his death through baptism, so they are to know a resurrection like his.

GOSPEL: (Matthew 10:24-39) Jesus warns his disciples of troubles to come, but offers them assurance of the Father's care and his own readiness to support them before God as they speak up for him.
